# REGULATIONS ON BEER & WINE

Selling beer and wine brings with it a responsibility and liability. There are some rules or legalities we need to bring to your attention. 1. No one is to go behind the counter in the pro shop where the beer is except those who work there. 2. Therefore, No one is to get their own beer out the cooler. 3. Beer is not to be brought on the golf course premises by members or guests. 4. The only beer or wine consumed on golf course property is that which is bought by the golf course from a distributor. 5. We have the right to refuse to sell beer to any member or guest. 6. If you were to leave this course and have an accident, we would immediately get a visit from an ALE officer. We could be held liable.

In that case, we would lose our alcohol license.

- 7. When you bring beer from home and drink beer here as well, we have no control over how much you have consumed.
- 8. NO COOLERS FROM HOME ALLOWED NOT EVEN COOLERS LEFT IN YOUR VEHICLE.
